

## PALM POINTE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

2018-2019 Enrollment Closed

**2019-2020 Online Registration will open September 1, 2018 – February 1, 2019**

Thank you for your interest in Palm Pointe. Since we are a charter laboratory school we have to follow certain guidelines and must mirror the states demographics. Unfortunately if you did not apply for the lottery, which closed February 1, 2018, then it is not possible for your children to attend Palm Pointe for the 2018-2019 school year.

Registration for the lottery opens September 1, 2018 and closes February 1, 2019 at the following web address [applypk12.fau.edu/apply](http://applypk12.fau.edu/apply) for the 2019-2020 next school year. ***Please write down your log in information as you will need it to accept the seat on the dashboard if your child is selected.***

All students that are currently attending Palm Pointe will progress into the next grade each year, they do not need to reapply once they have been accepted. If we have any spots that are vacated by current students, the student that replaces him/her must match demographically. The lottery selection and admission process are ongoing since students withdraw throughout the year, your child could be selected any month during the school year and you will have the opportunity to accept the seat at that time. You do not have to live in Tradition in order to attend Palm Pointe and residing in Tradition does not guarantee you acceptance. We accept students from all over St. Lucie County. Facts:

- Palm Pointe does not handle the lottery process, FAU handles the entire process. No one employed by Palm Pointe or St. Lucie County Schools has the ability to place a student at Palm Pointe.
- Students enrolling for Kindergarten, you must apply the year prior to them starting Kindergarten.
- Sibling preference is given and FAU tries to get all siblings enrolled but it is not guaranteed.
- There is not a numbered wait list. The lottery process pulls from demographics only when a vacancy needs to be filled. Your child may be selected anytime during the school year.
- FAU will send you an acceptance email from the following email address [coepk12@fau.edu](mailto:coepk12@fau.edu) please make sure you add this to your address book so it does not go into your junk or spam email. FAU emails are sent out in bulk and your email account may send it to junk/spam, please be aware of this.
- Review acceptance information once you receive an email from FAU offering your child a seat at Palm Pointe. You have **3** days to accept the seat and **5** days to complete registration packet at Palm Pointe. If you do not accept the seat in the timeframe you forfeit you child's seat.
- If your child is not selected for the year that you applied, you must apply the following year. The lottery system does not roll over to the next school year.
- St. Lucie County offers many great schools and offers School Choice. You should contact the Student Assignment Office at 4204 Okeechobee Road, Ft. Pierce, Florida (772)429-3930 and they will assist you in placing your child in a current school.
