-Orbiter says no need to send in money wait until you get the photo – which is what we did before, BUT the picture form says \$12 has to be sent into school prior to the picture being taken) Didn't notice that problem last year like I did this year. I could have easily missed that Vocabulary parade since I wrote down first what the Orbiter said and it was incorrect. Same with the field trip. I understand things slip by and things can change after print, but it is still very frustrating as a parent to have that newsletter have incorrect information.
-Palm Pointe has been a breath of fresh air this year. I can't say enough positive things! Comment: My child has had a great year at Palm Pointe. He's always excited to learn. Great job with getting families involved. Keep it up!
-Suggestion: iStation is a very good program. We would suggest having similar programs for all core subject areas. Additionally, I would suggest having off campus field trips. My son is in kindergarten, and hasn't had any off campus field trips. It would also be great to get feedback from the teacher about classroom assignments and tests and not just their behavior.
-I am extremely pleased with the school. My children are doing extremely well and are very happy to be at this school. Keep up the GREAT work! Feedback/Comment: Intramural sports – I feel you need to have staff with the knowledge, experience, and the passion to coach any intramural team. The schedule (with specific tournament dates) for all sports needs to be communicated to participants at the beginning of the season. I felt the communication between staff and parents was poor. Students and parents need to be notified of schedule changes in a more timely manner. I'm disappointed that other schools have uniforms for their students and participate in more than one game/tournament. Lastly, I think the staff needs parent assistance in the running the Intramural program. Grading in Skyward needs to be updated at least on a biweekly basis for all teachers and before the end of the nine weeks.
-Suggestions: A consistent ENFORCED dress code policy across all grade levels with consequences for not following policy. On more than one occasion I had to reassure my children that only school approved colored sweat jackets are allowed even though other students wore out of dress code colors all day. Add No dress code days to benefit each grade level to help with teacher out of pocket expenses, cost of class field trips, snacks and supplies. Reduce paper waste and cost by designating one student per family, at the beginning of the school year, to receive school hand outs. I would like to suggest having multiple field days (like Martin County) to encourage exercise, monitor physical activity and track progress of students. Ask for parent volunteers to assist the PE department.

I am totally dissatisfied with this school and its ability as a whole to nurture and help the students grow. All effort is spent on creating mindless automatons and to push as much of the state required information on the students as possible with little or no

parental communication. Having my children at this school has pushed me more towards charter and private education.

divided up into other 4th grade classes. (I can't remember if there was a notice sent home about it – there's an awful lot of little pieces of paper sent home.) A teacher should have been hired to cover the class.
