

Spring PM3 Test Dates

Spring is the season for State Assessments! This year writing and K-2 Reading and Math will be administered in April. All other assessments are scheduled for the month of May. It is critical that vacations and other appointments are not made to conflict with your child's test days. Teachers plan exciting Crunch-Time lessons based upon when students are scheduled for their FAST tests and participation creates a confident, prepared learner! Specific letters with details for individual Progress Monitoring 3 (PM3) grade level tests and directions will be sent home this month. Families may view sample items and sample tests with their Gr. K-8 children by visiting this link: Students & Families (flfast.org) All students are required to participate in the state assessment program. Lack of participation can result in the absence of vital data used for scheduling and placement. Please help us from home by having your child get a good night's rest, eating a healthy breakfast on the morning of each test, and arriving at school on time. Additionally, students must keep all electronic devices (e.g. cell phones, smart watches, Bluetooth earbuds, etc.) out of the testing environment. We ask for your help by ensuring your child understands that all cell phones and other devices will be turned off and kept out of the classroom during testing. Please keep smart watches and Bluetooth/wireless headphones/earbuds home on these days. We appreciate your support during this testing season!

Dismissal Procedures

Palm Pointe would like to thank our families for adhering to the changes that have taken place to our dismissal process. We are committed to improving our car lines and dismissal will begin the earliest in these lines. We start each afternoon at 3:54. Walkers/bike riders will be dismissed at approximately 4:15 each day in order to allow our car lines to start and proceed quickly. As a reminder, you may be ticketed for illegal parking in the surrounding neighborhoods.

PikMyKid is our dismissal system, and we are asking <u>all families</u> to be sure to utilize the app. With this system, you are able to designate your child's daily dismissal and are able to make changes when needed, such as for after-school activities like tutoring, clubs or sports. This information is used daily to dismiss students from class to their designated dismissal area and it is critical that it is updated. We also need **ALL carline riders need to have their child's tag in their window, even if you think staff members know you. Not having this slows down our line.** We appreciate your help with this and support of our efforts to make dismissal a safe and smooth process.
