FSA Testing Information

The Florida Department of Education has established April and May windows of dates for administering the Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) for Writing, Reading, Math, Science, and End-of-Course Assessments (Civics and Algebra 1). In April, the FSA exam for Reading in grade 3 and FSA Writing for grades 4-8 will be taken. All other exams will take place in May. All students, whether traditional on campus or MySchool Online virtual, will be provided the opportunity to participate in the Spring assessments. Test and exam results are used to measure student proficiency and growth, and these results help to properly place and schedule students the following year into appropriate classes. MySchool Online virtual students will be notified of participation details soon, as all tests must be taken on campus. The safety and health of each and every student is paramount to us. Please know that strict protocols and procedures are in place as we host MySchool Online students for state testing. Students will be greeted upon drop off, and supervised at all times. We understand and recognize that this may be their first time on campus this year and we will do all we can to make your child comfortable and feel welcomed and safe. Safe social distancing will be maintained. Students must always wear a mask and sanitizer will be utilized. Students will be encouraged to bring their own water bottles. Students will enter the building through a stairway not normally for student use. Students will be tested in one of two smaller groups in separate campus classrooms that have been and will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized before and after each time the room is used. Students will be in testing locations that are not regular instructional classrooms and, therefore, will not be interacting with traditional school students on campus. Adherence to the St. Lucie Public Schools' *Safe Return to School Plan* will be followed. Specific details of testing dates and times for all students will follow soon.
