
100 Book Challenge

The more your child spends reading at his or her independent level, the better reader he or she will become.

2nd Grade Writing Curriculum



The 2nd grade Writing curriculum will include:

- Legible handwriting, correct spelling of grade level words, proper grammar and sentence structure.
- Narrative Writing: recounting a personal or fictional experience or telling a story based on a real or imaginary events.
- <u>Informational/ Explanatory Writing:</u> giving information, explaining how or why, clarifying a process, or defining a concept.
- Focus: main idea, theme, or unifying point.
- Organization: structure or plan of development.
- **Support/Details:** details to explain, clarify, or define.



- Student success in math greatly depends on their mastery of basic facts. Please make sure to practice math facts(out of order) daily. We are looking for speed and accuracy. There are a variety of ways to practice such as:
